

LIHEAP Priority Periods

October 1st: Eligible applicants are those aged 60 or older, disabled individuals, and households where the furnace is non-operational or red tagged by the Utility Company.

November 1st: Eligible applicants are those aged 60 or older, disabled individuals, households that are disconnected, old/charged-off bills, households where the furnace is non-operational or red tagged by the Utility Company, and households with children under the age of 6 years.

December 1st: Opens to general public.

Items needed for LIHEAP

- ✓ Social Security Cards for **everyone** in the household
- ✓ Photo ID
- ✓ Current medical/Link card
- ✓ Current utility bill
- ✓ 30 days proof of **ALL** household income

Items needed for Furnace Assistance

- ✓ Social Security Cards for **everyone** in the household
- ✓ Photo ID
- ✓ Current medical/Link card
- ✓ Current utility bill
- ✓ 30 days proof of **ALL** household income
- ✓ Proof of homeownership (property taxes, title, etc.)
- ✓ Furnace must be inoperable or red tagged via utility company

Items needed for Disconnected Utilities and/or Old Bills

- ✓ Social Security Cards for **everyone** in the household
- ✓ Photo ID
- ✓ Current medical/Link card
- ✓ Current utility bill
- ✓ 30 days proof of **ALL** household income
- ✓ Old utility bill
- ✓ **FOR OLD BILLS ONLY**: Lease or letter from landlord stating who will be living in the residence, what utilities you are responsible for, and the new address where service will be needed.

Various types of income include but are not limited to:

- ✓ Wages (Full, part-time, and temporary employment)
- ✓ Social Security income SSA/SSI (letter or printout)
- ✓ Unemployment (30 days/check stubs or printout)
- ✓ Child Support/Alimony
- ✓ Pension
- ✓ TANF/AABD (DHS Cash Assistance)
- ✓ General Assistance from a Township
- ✓ VA Benefits
- ✓ Workers Compensation
- ✓ Rental Income
- ✓ Adoption/Foster Subsidy
- ✓ Self-employment income (Ledger, check stubs, receipts needed)
